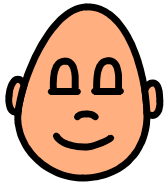


Everyone likes to be happy.

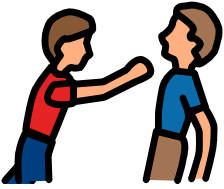


safe

hit

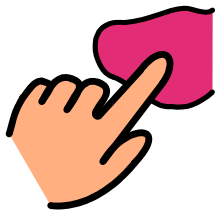


sad

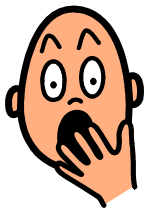


It sometimes makes people

scared

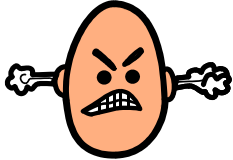


Sometimes when I put my hands on someone, it makes them feel scared because they don't feel safe.
