


Tapping Flashcards

Cut out these flashcards to practice tapping and reading words. Show the card to the student. Have the student tap and read the word. For an extension, have the student use the word in a sentence that shows meaning. See answer sheet for tapping key.




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Tapping Flashcards Answer Sheet

A digraph is two letters that make one sound (**ch**, **ck**, **sh**, **th**, **wh**), so it gets only one tap. After the student taps and reads the word, ask the student to isolate the vowel sound. Ask: "What is the vowel sound in that word?" (i.e. in "**lock**", it is /**ŏ**/.)



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
